Exam and Assessment Schedules

Students, it is critical that you complete all scheduled assessment and exams by the due dates. If you are unable to attend a scheduled exam or submit an assessment item on the due date, you need to communicate with the school immediately with a valid reason to ensure that you may still have the assessment counted towards your semester's result. Valid reasons are outlined in the **Assessment Policy (PDF 234 KB).**

Not contacting the school is likely to see a student with a non-submit for the missed exam or assessment item. This may mean that a student is not-rated for the semester, which could have a significant impact on your pathway and ability to achieve their QCE, or continued enrolment in subjects in the following semester.
