SENIOR PRIVILEGES

Privileges will be afforded to students in the Senior School based on their ability to meet the school's expectations, which include demonstrating the school's STARS expectations of Spirit, Teamwork, Accountability, Respect and Safety.

In particular, during the compulsory participation phase, we

- recognise students who consistently meet the school expectations for attendance, behaviour, effort and participation
- · reinforce with students that privileges are granted to students who meet the school's expectations
- build a culture which encourages students to be self-managing in meeting their responsibilities maintaining attendance, submitting assessment, accounting for all absences from school by bringing in notes and medical certificates, wearing the full school uniform and regulating their behaviour.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SENIOR JERSEY

We want every Year 11 student be an eligible to purchase a senior jersey, therefore we ask that you discuss the above requirements with your parents/carers and we encourage you to do everything you can to achieve this. All school fees must either be finalised or an agreed payment plan in place with regular payments being made before jerseys can be purchased.
