

Ingeborgm Elfriede Leibnitz Scholarship

Yeppoon State High School

Each year, Year 12 students may apply for the *Ingeborgm Elfriede Leibnitz scholarship* of up to \$4000 to assist them in their tertiary studies. The scholarship will be paid in two instalments each year for up to 4 years. The scholarship is designed to support students with social or financial hardship. The bursary was the legacy of Mr Graham Page who did a lot of work including out of hours tutoring for our school for many years. Our oval is named after Mr Page. When he passed away, he left his estate to his wife Inge who was more than happy to leave her entire estate to the school, when she passed away. Inge worked at CQU and was studying a degree when she passed away. Yeppoon High students were so thankful to Mr Page at the time that they delved into the astrology charts and found a star in the universe that was not named. They did a full authentication of that star and received the certificate, with the seal of registration being awarded on 15/5/08 to show their appreciation of the tireless work of Mr Page. The *Public Trustee* office administers the estate funds for the purpose of the ongoing scholarships being made available to Yeppoon High graduates for many years to come.

For:	Students undertaking a Bachelor Degree (on-line or on campus) at an accredited tertiary institution.			
Value:	Each year, up to THREE students will be selected, based on the criteria outlined below. The selection panel will consist of the Principal and 2 community representatives. The value of the scholarship will be up to \$4000 per year, and payments will be ongoing for a total of 4 years, if all subjects are passed.			
Initial Eligibility:	 A student at Yeppoon State High School for all of Year 12. QCE attainment – a copy of your senior certificate is to be attached to your application. Acceptance into a Bachelor course (on campus or on-line) – university offer to be provided. Low socio-economic* / diversity situation (with Centrelink / Health Card or statutory declaration). 			
Ongoing Eligibility:	 Students must email confirmation of passing all subjects to principal@yeppoonshs.eq.edu.au Students will need to scan and email their results in a timely manner each semester. These may be emailed to the school and the Department of Public Trustees. Details provided after acceptance. 			
Format and due date:	A formal application letter outlining the reason why you would benefit from receiving this scholarship. This letter may outline any circumstances that support hardship or challenge for you to undertake tertiary studies. The letter must include TWO referees, with at least one being a member of the Yeppoon State High community. Applications close on 15 January each year.			
Commitment:	An undertaking to complete the full degree course full time and passing all subjects.			
Right of appeal:	The selection of Scholarship recipients is the decision of the Panel. There will not be an appeal process as the panel's decision is final.
