

2026 YEAR 11 & 12 STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

Stationery and Subject Requirements

General stationery items and Compulsory Subject requirements will need to be purchased by individual students/parents/carers prior to the commencement of school and are not part of the Student Resource Scheme.

It is advisable to purchase the requirements for the Elective subjects after the student has commenced school as students will not be advised of their chosen Elective subjects until after they commence school. With different individual pathway subjects, the students will select from Technology and The Arts in each Semester.

An itemised list of all requirements is provided over the page.

A4 Exercise Books/Folders

It is recommended that students have a <u>separate</u> lined A4 Exercise book for <u>each</u> subject. (Some subjects like SOSE and Mathematics require an A4 Exercise book not a folder, as the notebook is collected regularly for marking). If the student uses a single folder, please ensure there are separate divisions within the folder for each subject. Experience has shown that the work/notes quickly become mixed up and are often lost if there are no separators. It is useful to have a display folder or ring binder per subject to collect handouts/tests, etc.

Clothing Requirements

The school dress code requires fully enclosed footwear to be worn at all times. This is a workplace health and safety requirement.

Student Resource Scheme

Parents/carers are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other resources for their children while attending school. A Student Resource Scheme enables parents to contract with the school for the temporary use of textbooks and other equipment and to purchase consumables and materials for their children in return for a specified fee. It is designed to reduce the costs of supplying textbooks and other resources to parents through bulk purchasing. Computer Policy

It is essential that students comply with the school's *ICT Network - Acceptable Use Policy*. If students lose computer access, their results could be affected. A copy of the Policy is available in the enrolment package.

BYOx Policy

Students in year 11 and 12 will be required to participate in the Bring Your Own Device Program (BYOx). We believe that it is vital our students become members of the 21st Century digital economy, and a key part of this learning will take place through digital technology at YSHS. Please Note: If your student is likely to study a science subject in Year 11 (Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Marine Studies) then the preferred device is a Laptop.
