SPECIAL AWARDS:

Brian & Olive Dorey Achievement Awards

This award recognises the achievement of a Year 7 student who has demonstrated enthusiasm and ability in the areas of writing, music and art.

Livingstone Shire Council Cultural Award

This award celebrates the rich cultural talent that exists in our school community. A student who has contributed to a range of cultural pursuits will receive this award.

Livingstone Shire Council Community Service Award

The Livingstone Shire Council Community Service Award recognises a student who has assisted and supported those less fortunate in the community. The recipient has worked consistently throughout the year and taken a high profile in organising and running fundraising and other key community service events.

Sportsmanship Award

Stewie Harald Shield

This award is presented by the Vietnam Veteran's Association to honour local Yeppoon man, Stewie Harald who was the first man from the region to be killed in action in the Vietnam War. It is presented to a senior student who has participated in a wide range of activities, has shown initiative and enthusiasm, has demonstrated organisational skills and is a great team player.

Caltex All Rounder

The Caltex All Rounder Award is presented to a student who has shown impeccable participation and excellence in academic, leadership, sporting and community service activities. They are nominated and judged by their school and peers and participate actively in all aspects of school life.

University of Queensland Create Change Achievement Award
