Under this agreement for 2020  
Yeppoon State High School will receive

**\$486 957\***

## This funding will be used to

- Improve student behaviour, effort, and percentage achieving a C or higher across Years 7-12 to 90%.
- Improve student average daily attendance by at least 1% across school, to come closer to our 90% target.
- Improve student writing by 5% in percentage above National Minimum Standard (NMS) and 5% increase in the top 3 bands (Years 7 & 9).

## Our initiatives include

- Our 2020 AIP and action planning templates unpack our priorities for our pillars of communication and engagement.
- Our evidence based approaches include the implementation of:
  - School-wide consistent pedagogical approach to writing (Write that Essay).
  - PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning) and related resourcing across the school.
  - Indigenous programs through interagency and Indigenous Community Education Counsellor (CEC) and teacher aide.
  - Upskilling staff to support access and participation of students in English and Maths.
  - At-risk students (attendance) through Youth Worker programs and connections in Years 7-9.
  - Case Management of at-risk students, with additional certificate programs for Year 12's.
  - Equity pool for at-risk students to include uniforms, e-devices, stationery, fee support.
  - Digital access provision for all text books to allow 24-hour access for all students.
