SENIOR PRIVILEGES

The final year of Senior Schooling is an important period in your life. To prepare for your next phase, it is essential that you attend every lesson to give yourself the best opportunity to succeed. **Privileges** will be afforded to students in the Senior School based on their ability to meet the school's expectations, which include demonstrating the school's STARS expectations of Spirit, Teamwork, Accountability, Respect and Safety.

In particular, during the compulsory participation phase, we

- recognise students who consistently meet the school expectations for attendance, behaviour, effort and participation
- reinforce with students that privileges are granted to students who meet the school's expectations
- build a culture which encourages students to be self-managing in meeting their responsibilities – maintaining attendance, submitting assessment, accounting for all absences from school by bringing in notes and medical certificates, wearing the full school uniform and regulating their behaviour.

ELIGIBILITY TO ATTEND THE FORMAL

We want every Year 12 student be a part of the Formal ceremony, therefore we ask that you discuss the above requirements with your parents/carers and we encourage you to do everything you can to achieve this. All school fees must be finalised before tickets can be purchased. We ask that, if you are on a payment plan, you check that your regular instalments are sufficient to be able to finalise payments before tickets go on sale (usually around week 2 of term 4). We urge you to commit yourself to these final months of your schooling to set yourself up for a bright future. For further clarity, please discuss any of your queries with the HOD of Senior School.




APPEALS PROCESS
